'Cause I'm working, working from home.

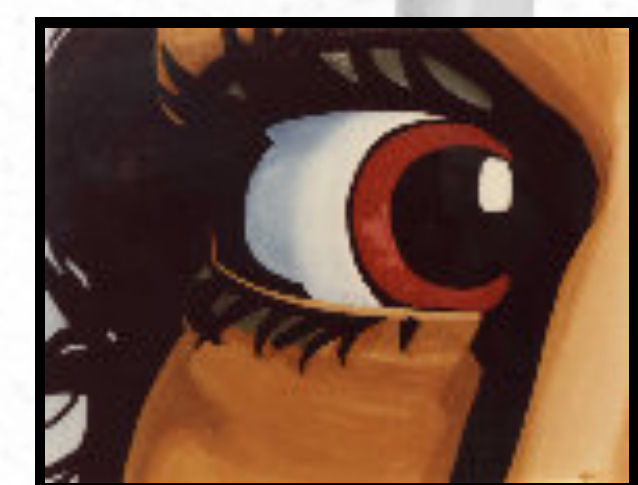
